Kenny Farrell

Director of Coaching

In 2003, Kenny Farrell co-founded the Shell Shockers Soccer Team and was named Head Coach. He received the PDL's prestigious "Coach of the Year" title after a spectacular first season in 2003, winning more games than any other team in the country. Coach Farrell played professional soccer for the Shelbourne Football Club in the League of Ireland and also starred for Salem State College, competing in the NCAA Final Four. He has a wide range of contacts in the soccer world, both nationally and internationally. After settling in New Orleans, he became Director of Coaching for Lafreniere Soccer Club, leading them to 25 State Championships. Coach Farrell was one of the first Board Members for the U.S. Club Soccer Association, was the U.S. Soccer Region III coach of the Olympic Development Program for the Louisiana Soccer Association, and was the head scout and coach for the USL Olympic Development Program for the Gulf South Region. Currently, Coach Farrell holds a USSF A license and serves on the Executive Committee for the USL-PDL.



Ben Callon

Director of Operations

A native of Blackburn, England, Ben Callon returns to New Orleans after playing with the New Orleans Shockers last season. Ben graduated with a degree in Business Management and also holds an MBA in Entrepreneurship. He is a former Youth International for England. He also played for Burnley FC as a youth and later represented Lancashire Academy for 2 years. Ben played college soccer in Ohio for NAIA Champions the University of Rio Grande. During his college career, he received multiple honors including being named a 1st team All-American three times and accumulated honors within the AMC conference. Ben played for the Columbus Shooting Stars and the Nevada Wonders before playing for the New Orleans Shockers. Ben is a UEFA B licensed coach with a wealth of experience coaching camps and coaching at the collegiate level.
